Dear Pastor and Church family,  
Even though most things in Spain grind down to a slow crawl in the summer, God has blessed us with many visitors, and we would ask you to pray as some of them are looking for a church home and some are still unsaved.  
The family of Luis and Mariela, daughters: Antonella (3), and Fiorella (9 months) from Venezuela have been with us for a month. Wendy (from Dominican Republic) and her 4 year old daughter, Charlotte are coming faithfully each Sunday. Carmen from Equatorial Guinea came regularly while she was in Madrid visiting her daughter. Rocio and her 83 year old mom, Betty, that soon she will be saved. Javier, who is Laura's husband (they are both Spaniards), has been away from the Lord for over 20 years, and recently came a bit early to pick his wife and was able to hear part of the sermon. Bryan and Ivan, from the Dominican Republic, received a grant to study in a Master's program in Madrid. During their time here, Bryan, who is a believer, brought Ivan to church. Ivan completed 6 lessons on the book of John, but left us without making a profession of faith. Even though some of our visitors are just passing through, God has used them to encourage and bless the work.

**Ethiopian Work Team.** What a surprise God gave us in the month of June of hosting a team from Ethiopia for 13 days who came to help prepare for the 4 weeks of camp at Mount Calvary Baptist Youth Camp. There were 4 of them and they are our family, Eric, Amanda, Kayla and Aaron Shadle! Their 4 pair of hands helped us accomplish so many things at camp. They returned to Ethiopia and the next day we hosted the counselor's training day at church as well as on line for counselors in several different cities around Spain.
