Bluie Sterling - her physical needs, her condition has been deteriorating recently as she sleeps more and more

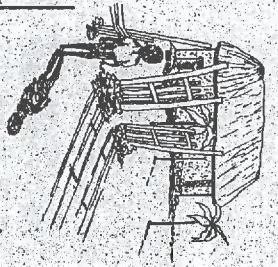
Elizabeth Fournier, a friend of Lauren Acton - she is 33, she has a couple chemo treatments left

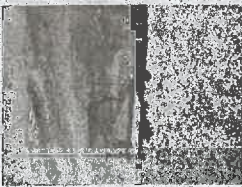

Dear Pastor and Church family,

Email communication from Haiti has been encouraging. In June Milande, one of the children's teacher who was married in December 2016, was planning to do a program in the province area near where she grew up and her family still lives. An area in which a child has no value shown to them. Several years ago, she and several of her Christian friends planned a special program for the children of the area and it was approved by the local mayor. Thus this year she plans to do it. Since I have not received a report, I am trusting it means she is spending the summer in that area to do more evangelizing. It is a custom in the churches I have worked with, to take a "Mission trip" into the province (country side) during the school vacation time for about a week of evangelization. It always thrills my heart to hear their excitement as they tell about where they plan to go and hearing about their time after they return.



Another exciting communication has been from Pastor Violand. Desiring writing to let me know that on July 10<sup>th</sup> his church was going to start putting in the foundation for their church building. They have been in a make shift building (can be seen in the photo to your left) since the church started after the earthquake in 2010. I have lost track of how many times they have had to repair or rebuild it. Here are a few photos during the building. I am looking forward to seeing it in person on my next visit. I am planning for October. Lord willing.



Thank you for all your prayers and support. Please continue to pray for the churches faithfulness, continued spiritual growth, safety and the Lord to continue to meet their personal needs.
