We have went through a couple of busy weeks.....in November we had family camp, (a real success) then we prepared to help our community with "Carols by Candle light (right after we set up the rain came and came down so hard that they cancelled it...so we had to tear all the tents and so forth down, in the rain). Then came our Church's Thanksgiving & Christmas dinner. Yes you heard me correctly this has been our 4th year to celebrate Thanksgiving in Australia...we had over 100 people attend that celebration.....We were so tired... by the New Year I didn't want to do anything.

Well it's January the 9th and I haven't wrote a prayer letter. I know we are overtime so here goes...this Sunday we are going to have our first Ordination in this Church. Our church is ordaining Mitchell Ellis Smith who has been working with us for the past year and a half. He is 25 and is ready to go.....he will be our first Australian Pastor in this church. Grace Baptist Church is ordaining him (which is the name of our church here in Australia) and he will take over in February. We have 6 pastors coming to be on the ordination council. The Ordination will take place 14 of January...a lot to get ready but our people will rally behind us...which will be a great day in the Lord's house.

That will free us up to go on to our next ministry but first we are going to come back to the States to report back to our churches and see family. This is our 4th Australian that we have had the privilege of Ordaining....looking forward to this Sunday with mixed emotions.

Thank you for making this possible....I hope you all had a Very Merry Christmas and I didn't have the opportunity to let you know....we are hoping, in Christ, that you will have a Blessed & Great New Year.
