Dear Pastor and Church family,

Ladies meeting. God blessed at the Regional Ladies meeting and we took 8 ladies and 2 teen girls. Sadly, Joy, who was the special speaker, came down with that nasty flu that was going around the world, and had to cancel at the last minute. Mari Carmen, the wife of the pastor of the host church, was able to take Joy's notes and give the 2 hours of bible teaching about the Good Shepherd. God is good.

Men's meeting. We were invited to a men's fellowship meeting in a sister-church in Azuqueca (about a 25 min. drive from Madrid) and 6 of our men were able to attend. In the picture, Ivan is the man on the left - front row. He continues to attend services each Sunday night and we pray he will soon be saved.

Camp meeting. There was a sweet spirit and we were voted in for another 2 years to be "Camp coordinators". That title means that we get to keep planning and preparing the 4 weeks of summer camps along with many pastors and missionaries from all over Spain! The physical work at camp has come to a stop as we've had lots and lots of rain recently. The rain is a blessing, but it makes it impossible for us to get any work done. How muddy is it at camp? I recently made a trip to camp and on the road before the camp entrance, I got stuck in the mud. Bro. Angel, the camp director, had to pull me out with the tractor! Pray that we will soon be able to return to work, as there are many projects we need to finish before camp begins in July.

God is in control. If you've followed the news in our prayers letters through the years, you know the work in Spain is slow and very difficult. In order to protect and respect the people we love, we will share that at the end of February we had a number of our families leave the church. We are healing by God's grace, by the prayers of fellow-pastors in Madrid and by sweet fellowship and encouragement from others who've walked this kind of a trial before us.

God's work. God is at work and we rejoice to share that Rita has begun a Bible study on Wednesdays and sometimes stays for prayer meeting afterwards. Pray she will soon be saved! She is now coming faithfully each Sunday morning which is encouraging.

Thank you so much for your faithful support and prayers for us. Often you pray without knowing all that we are going through physically (Joy had an out-patient surgery in Feb. that has taken awhile to heal) or spiritually, but God knows and we thank you for standing by us. Pray with us as we look towards our Missions Conference at the end of April. We want God to use the Iglesia Bautista Biblica in Madrid to reach souls around the world.
